

FERNBROOKE STATE SCHOOL - 3 Systems of Reward



SYSTEM 1 - Free and Frequent (White Perry Tickets/Points)

WHO: Class Teachers and Teacher Aides

WHAT: White Perry Tickets/Points

WHY: Frequent positive reinforcement of STARS behaviour

HOW: Class Teacher determines which method they use from below.

Method 1:

- Student receives ticket, writes their name on it, places it in the class box to be drawn from at a later time (end of the day/end of the week – Teacher's call)
- The Class Teacher draws up to 3 names from the box and those students whose names are drawn receive a preferably cost neutral prize (preferred activity time; teacher's helper for a day; time in the teacher's chair etc.)

Method 2:

- Student receives tickets and accumulates them to a certain number to receive a cost neutral prize (E.g. 20 tickets equals a prize)

NOTE: White tickets do not accumulate to SYSTEM 2 - Perry Passports

SYSTEM 2 - Perry Passports and Celebration of Learning Days

WHO: Class Teachers, Support Teachers, Specialist Teachers, Relief Teachers, Leadership Team

WHAT: 5, 3, 1 and Green or Gold Perry Tickets/Points

WHY: Mid to long term reward for consistent STARS behaviour

HOW: Perry Passport

- Teacher awards points for student's overall STARS behaviour throughout the day.
- Exceeding Expectations = 5 points Soaring = 3 points Ready to Learn = 1 point
- Five (5) Points equates to one (1) Stars Stamp in their passport.
- Green Perry Tickets (2 points) awarded by Specialist/NCT/Support Teachers/Relief Teachers and members of administration and the Principal's Gold Ticket (5 points) also accrue to this system to encourage students to do the right thing when they are not with their class teacher.
- The number of Stars Stamps in a student's passport by the beginning of Week 10 of each term determines their participation level at the end of term Celebration of Learning Day.
 - Tier one activity (0 – 19 Stamps)
 - Tier two activity (20 – 29 Stamps)
 - Tier three activity (30 – 39 Stamps)
 - Tier four activity (40+ Stamps)

SYSTEM 3 - Whole Class Perry STARS – 100 STARS Parties

WHO: Class Teachers, Support Teachers, Specialist Teachers, Relief Teachers, Leadership Team

WHAT: Whole class STARS

WHY: Encourage students to be accountable to each other and work together to achieve set goals

HOW: STARS awarded are placed on Large Perry poster in classrooms

- Teachers award Class Stars based on the class behaviour as a whole.
- Class STARS awarded by Specialist/NCT/Support Teachers/TRS providers and Leadership Team count as two STARS.
- On average classes aim to achieve 100 – 125 Perry Stars per term.
- Classes are recognised for achieving 100 Perry Stars in the school newsletters and receive a certificate presented by Admin.
- An added bonus is a class party, preferred activity or free time at the discretion of the teacher in consultation with their students.
