### Guidelines for student uniform

Fernbrooke State School is a uniformed school and we encourage all students to wear their uniforms each day, to foster school pride and equality.

Top		Fernbrooke School Polo or Long Sleeve Polo
Bottom		Black shorts /skorts / culottes
Hat		School Bucket Hat – Sports House Colour Freeman – <b>Yellow</b> Cahill - <b>Blue</b> Geitz – <b>Black</b> Thurston - <b>Red</b>
Shoes & Socks		Closed in black shoes no sandals or thongs. Short white socks
Winter		Black Long Pants or Track Suit Pants (No tights or bike shorts)  Black School Jacket with Logo or plain Black Jumper (NO Hoodies)
Sports Shirt		To be worn on the day the child does PE or on House Sports Carnival Days only: Freeman – <b>Yellow</b> Cahill - <b>Blue</b> Geitz – <b>Black</b> Thurston - <b>Red</b>
Cultural		We do ask children who wear some item of apparel for cultural reasons (e.g. Sikh or Muslim headwear, long trousers), that the items be in the school colours
<b>Personal Appearance</b>		
Hair		Collar length hair is to be plaited, braided or tied back with the appropriate school coloured accessories e.g. black or green. Hair should be well groomed in a neat and appropriate style and colour.
Jewellery		Watch Pierced earrings – small silver or gold studs and small sleepers Medical bracelet or necklace Items of significant cultural or religious beliefs
Nail Polish		Only clear nail polish is to be worn.
Make-up		It is not appropriate for any students to be wearing any form of make-up.
Personal Care		Deodorant – students who require deodorant at school must have roll-on or pump deodorant (no aerosol cans will be permitted)
